Descriptions of Board Positions

All Board Member Responsibilities (in additions to those listed below for specific positions):

- Attendance at board meetings
- Help develop Club678 or HSTY calendar prior to the beginning of the academic year
- Attendance at majority of youth group events
- Assist with Club Yeladim and Giva'ot events, as needed

PRESIDENT

- Preside over Youth Group Board meetings
- Create agendas for Youth Group meetings with the Youth Advisor
- Follow up regularly with Board Members
- Remain in close contact with the Youth Advisor
- Oversee fundraising

Programming Vice President

- Develop and maintain a high level of programming in the Youth Group
- Direct the creation and planning of all events during the year
- Plan and follow up on event details including location and supplies

Social Action Vice President

- Oversee any Social Action programming
- Plan, coordinate, and delegate responsibility for the Midnight Run event
- Plan and implement social action goals for each event

Religious and Cultural Vice President

- Work with the Youth Advisor to help compose religious services for events
- Incorporate religious and spiritual content into programming
- Supervise the worship content and services at HSTY events
- Work with the Youth Advisor to create engaging and innovative ways to conduct the High Holy Days Youth Services.

Membership Vice President

- Work with the Programming and Communications VPs to create event flyers in a timely manner
- Conduct and oversee reach out
- Establish contact with potential Youth Group event attendees before events and oversee follow-up

Communications Vice President

- Responsible for publicizing events within the synagogue and community
- Organize and coordinate board communication
- Assist with the preparation of flyers for all events
- Promote and recap events on social media

Secretary

- Record the minutes at the Youth Group Board meeting
- Ensuring reminders and event information is sent out on a regular basis
- Scheduling meetings for the Board or others as needed
- Delegating responsibilities while preparing for certain events

Grade Representative

- Represent your peers on the board
- Promote upcoming events
- Assist in the planning and operating of youth group events
