Who are these philanthropies?

- **Knead to Feed:** This is Temple Har Shalom's all-volunteer artisan *challah* bakery. Knead to Feed donates 100 percent of its net proceeds to help feed the hungry.
- **Friends of the Israeli Defense Force:** The mission of the FIDF is "to offer educational, cultural, recreational and social services programs and facilities that provide hope, purpose and life-changing support for the soldiers who protect Israel and Jews worldwide." The organization provides "for the wellbeing of IDF soldiers, veterans and family members."
- **Jewish Family Service:** JFS of Somerset, Hunterdon and Warren Counties "works to preserve and strengthen the quality of individual, family and community life based on Jewish values." They offer a number of support services from emergency food vouchers, career services and senior support services. Another important program is their Holocaust Survivor Assistance Program.
- **Yad LaKashish:** Focuses on empowering the elderly and providing creative work opportunities for thousands of Jerusalem's most deserving elderly residents. Many of the elderly at *Yad LaKashish* do not have nearby family, so they gain a sense of community and belonging through the programs. They are also dedicated to making an impact on the attitudes of the younger generation towards seniors. Program participants receive on-the-job training by professional artists and become part of a team in their designated craft.
